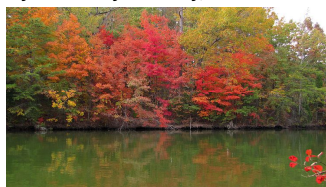

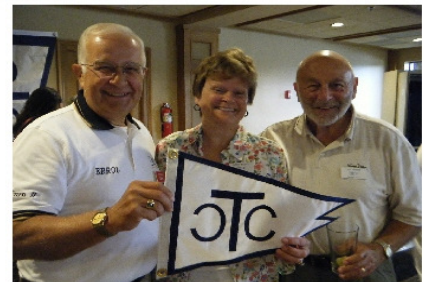

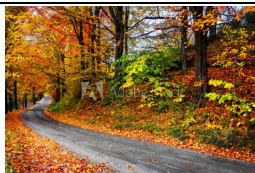

on Saturday, Oct. 24th

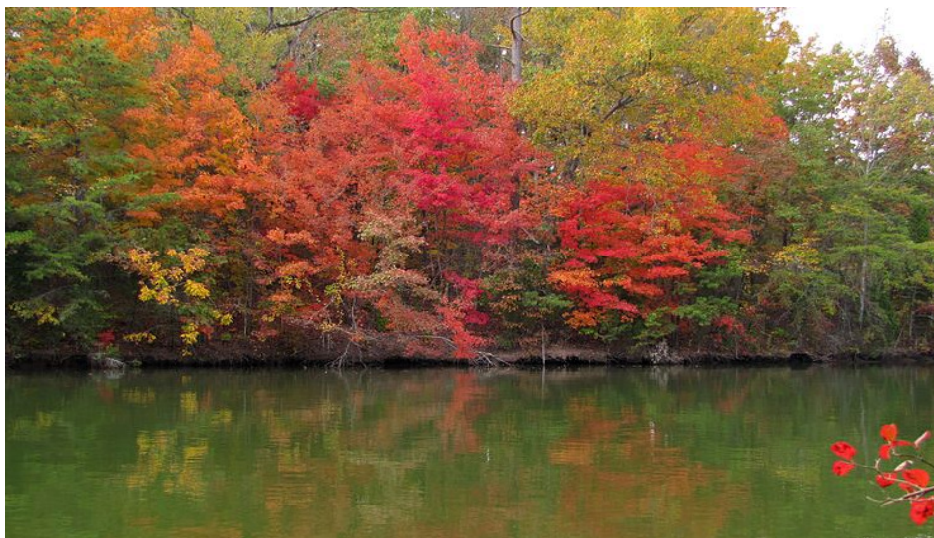
