The best wishes for the season. It is a time to enjoy family and friends, but also a time of reflection.

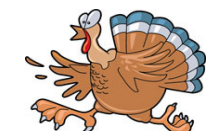

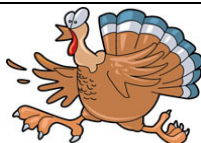
