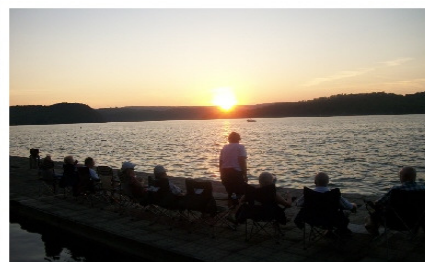

The 2016 TCC FALL CRUISE on Saturday, Oct. 15th

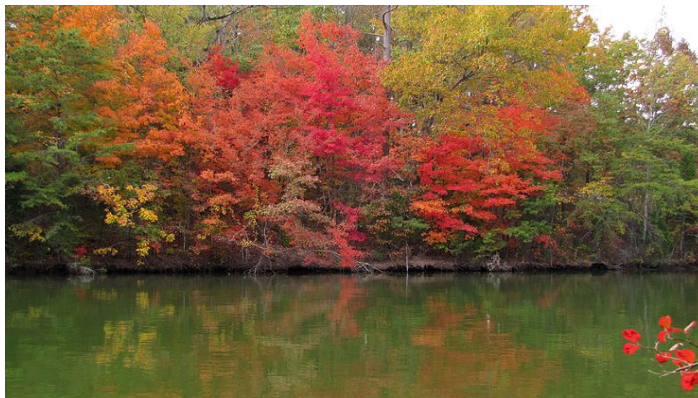
