ANNUAL TELLICO LAKE BLESSING OF THE FLEET

OPEN TO ALL VESSELS ON TELLICO LAKE

The **Blessing of the Fleet** is a tradition that began centuries ago in Mediterranean fishing communities. The practice is predominantly Catholic and a blessing from the local priest was meant to ensure a safe and bountiful season. However, both the ancient Greeks and Romans held elaborate ceremonies when their ships were christened, not much different from our ship launches of today. Parties were held; toasts of wine to the honored deity, a blessing from the high priest, and water poured over the boat were the basic events of the ceremony. Any deviation from these events was considered a bad omen, with the result being a tragedy at sea. Poseidon, who was considered the God of the sea, as well as earthquakes and horses, was a favorite of the Greeks to ask for protection. The Romans preferred Neptune, who was also considered a God of the sea. Some Native Americans, who painted symbols or animals on their canoes, also held launch ceremonies consisting of feasts, prayer and blessings.



Interested vessels will gather beginning at 9:30 am at Mile Marker 8.4 (the Sinking Creek inlet) and will follow the lead boat to the blessing at the Yacht Club visitor's dock. After the ceremony, join the revelry at the Tellico Village Pavilion on Tugaloo Lane for food, drinks, and friendship at 12:00

Cost: \$5 per boat. This is a "pot luck" so please remember to bring a dish to share with others, and your own beverage of choice.


Knoxville Power Squadron - Annual Lock-Thru and Picnic T-BART - Tellico Lake Orientation

If you have never been through a lock before this is your chance. Learning how to go through locks will open a whole new cruising world. You can go to places like Kingston, Chattanooga and beyond. Our Squadron will host its annual cruise through Fort Loudoun Lock on May 6. Following the lock-thru, we will have a picnic at Pavilion 1 in Lenoir City Park.

Those wanting to participate in going through the lock need to meet at Pavilion 1 at 0900 Hours for a short presentation/briefing to teach the basics of locking through. We will provide an experienced Squadron member to accompany you if you desire, or you can ride along in one of our boats. We hope to lock down as a group at 1000 hours (river traffic permitting).
