Fall Public Boating Class Presented by Knoxville Power Squadron

The Knoxville Power Squadron is offering its free* fall public boating class on. Tuesdays and Thursdays (four nights total class time) August 29th through September 7th at the Louisville, Tennessee City Hall, 3623 Louisville Rd, Louisville, TN 37777 from 6:00 p.m. until 8:30 p.m. each night. This course will cover boat types and terms, required safety equipment, operator responsibilities, navigational rules, navigation aids, lights and sounds, government regulations, state regulations, finding your way, anchoring, adverse conditions, communications, water sports, trailoring and PWC operation. There will be nightly assigned homework and answers will be provided and discussed. Everyone will receive the free**, 60 page, TWRA book, "BOAT TENNESSEE".

- ** For those born after January 1, 1989, who need the TWRA wallet card, there is a \$10 TWRA registration fee that will be explained in class. Those students will take the TWRA exam and once passed, will receive a temporary authorization sticker and later the required TWRA wallet card.
- * The course will be taught with slides and material from "AMERICA'S BOATING COURSE® " which is a more comprehensive, 270 page book by the United States Power Squadron®. The cost of the book and a six month trial membership in the Knoxville Power Squadron is \$37 per person or \$47 per couple, in one household, sharing a book.
